


However, the submission deadline is September 15th, 2014.

Your paper will be submitted online on NIM-A web site according to the following procedure:


- 1/ Go to http://ees.elsevier.com/nima proceedings/
- 2/ Click on "Register Now" to create your author account or use you login and password to Log in.
- 3/ Log in



4/ Click on "Submit a New Manuscript"



5/ Follow the link choosing to submit a "Special Issue: NDIP14" in the type of paper.



6/ Then, follow the instructions to submit your paper.

Principal recommendations to write your NDIP14 paper in the special issue of NIM-A:

- 1/ Your paper length must be 4-NIM-A pages maximum, including figures, tables and references.

Summary here after:

- Submit in different files:
 - Text including references, (The text should be in single-column format, add line numbers to the text for referees). Eventually, indicate in the text where you would like your figures or tables to appear.
 - Figure and Table Captions
 - o Figures
 - Tables
- No special formatting is required but double space may help reviewers.
- Pay attention to signs, symbols and formulae that may fail at pdf conversion time. In this case try to submit directly a pdf file.
- In order to make sure that your paper fits into the 4 pages length, NIM-A templates will be joined for word and Latex. In case of any other document editor, please ask the committee.
