

Dear Authors,

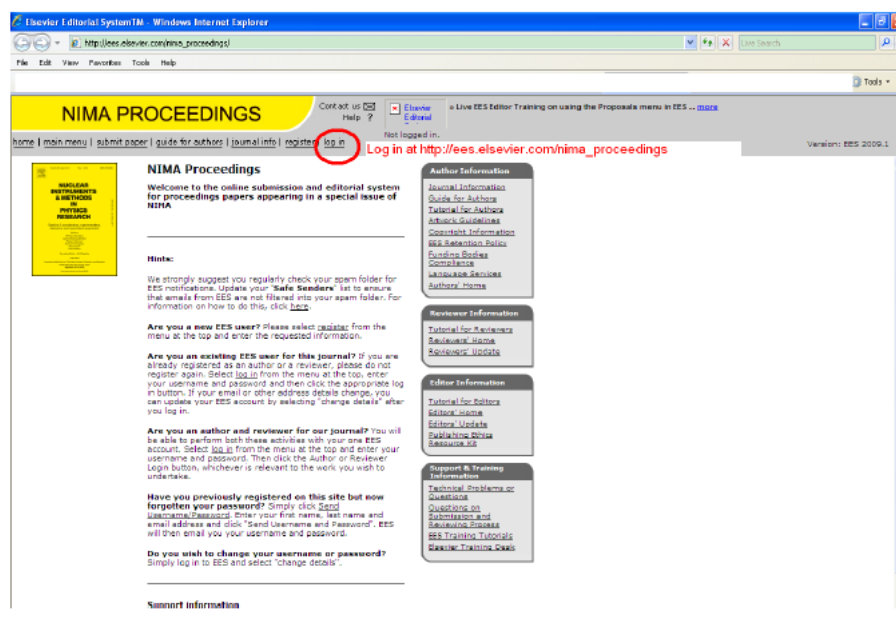

Principal recommendations to write your NDIP14 paper in the special issue of NIM-A:

1/ Your paper length must be 4-NIM-A pages maximum, including figures, tables and references.

Summary here after:

- Submit in different files:
 - o Text including references, (The text should be in single-column format, add line numbers to the text for referees). Eventually, indicate in the text where you would like your figures or tables to appear.
 - o Figure and Table Captions
 - o Figures
 - o Tables
- No special formatting is required but double space may help reviewers.
- Pay attention to signs, symbols and formulae that may fail at pdf conversion time. In this case try to submit directly a pdf file.
- In order to make sure that your paper fits into the 4 pages length, NIM-A templates will be joined for word and Latex. In case of any other document editor, please ask the committee.
